

Clarifoil, the Phthalates Directive and Other Materials

According to Directive 2005/84/EC, the 22nd amendment of the Council Directive 76/769/EEC, the following six materials must not be used in toys and childcare articles:

- DEHP – di-(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate
- DBP – di-n-butyl phthalate
- BBP – butyl benzyl phthalate
- DINP – diisononyl phthalate
- DIDP – diisodecyl phthalate
- DNOP – di-n-octyl phthalate

We confirm that none of these materials are used in the manufacture of T17 and T24 film.

Other materials that are regularly enquired about include:

- Latex
- Phthalates
- Bisphenol A or tetrabromobisphenol A (BPA / TBBP-A)
- ITX [2-Isopropyl Thioxanthone]
- Benzophenone
- GMO [Genetically Modified Organisms]
- Nano-particles [less than 100nm]
- Known allergens
- Isocyanates
- Halogenated compounds
- Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH's)
- Polyvinyl chloride (PVC)
- Hexabromocyclododecane (HBCDD)
- Perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS)

We confirm that none of these materials are used in the manufacture of any Clarifoil film.
