Multi-Plastics, Inc. Statement of PFAS Compounds

In response to your question regarding the absence/presence of both perfluoroalkyl and/or polyfluoroalkyl compounds (PFAS) in our products we offer the following statement. None of the products sold by Multi-Plastics, Inc. contain the following chemicals:

- ✓ Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA)
- ✓ Perfluorooctane Sulfonate (PFOS)
- ✓ Hexafluoropropylene Oxide-dimer Acid (HFPO-DA)
- ✓ Perfluorononanoic Acid (PFNA)
- ✓ Perfluorohexanesulfonic Acid (PFHS)
- ✓ Perfluoroheptanoic Acid (PFHA)
- ✓ Perfluorohexanoic Acid (PFHxA)
- ✓ Perfluorodecanoic Acid (PFDA)
- ✓ Perfluorobutanoic Acid (PFBA)
- ✓ Any other chemical substance or polymer containing a CF₂ or CF₃ element.

None of these chemicals are intentionally added, nor are they contained in any of the raw materials used to make our products, nor are they present in the manufacturing environments or in the local water supply. Therefore, we hereby declare our film and sheet products to be **100% PFAS free materials**. However, please also be advised that Multi-Plastics does not test for these chemicals in any of our products and we have no information or expectation that they would be present at any level.

This PFAS statement is in effect for all PLA, polystyrene, polyester, polyethylene, polypropylene and diacetate based products sold by Multi-Plastics including **FNABWP Balewrap**. This statement also includes full compliance with California AB-1200 restrictions.
